


# **Dulles Airport History**

- First new airport in the world designed for the Jet Age
- Main Terminal designed by Eero Saarinen and was meant to evoke flight





# **Siting of Dulles Airport**




- Airport is 26 miles west of DC
- Site chosen to ensure sufficient space for
  - Long runways
  - Expansion of terminal facilities
  - Buffer zone to minimize noise pollution
  - Ease of access




# Washington Dulles International Airport

- ~12,100 total acres with ~4,000 acres on AOA
- 26+ million passengers
- Can handle 55 million passengers
- 92 passenger loading bridges
- 139 aircraft parking positions
- 49 airlines serving 93 dom and 61 int'l destinations
- Approximately 1,000 operations per day
- United represents about 68% of our business
- Located in Loudoun and Fairfax Counties
- 3 fire stations and 1 police station
- 4th runway built in 2008
- 5th runway currently in our master plan
- 16 mile Dulles Airport Access Road
- 14 mile Dulles Toll Road









### Runway 12/30 East End Repairs

Spring 2025 (Tentative)

- Portions of the east end of runway 12/30 and taxiways Z and Y11 that were reconstructed in 2022 have defects.
- Slab replacements are tentatively scheduled for Spring 2025.
- Potential impacts for a 3-week project:
  - One-week full closure of runway
     12/30 for demo and concrete work.
  - Two additional weeks of intersection departures from taxiway Y (9,600 feet available).











# Dulles Toll Road Traffic Study at Rt 7




#### 2025 & Beyond - Parking Garages


